Phenomenology is a radical psychological and philosophical practice that has been a central influence in European philosophy this century. The early protagonists have influenced psychology, social psychology, sociology, psychopathology and anthropology (Brentano 1973, Husserl 1970a, 1975a, Heidegger 1962, Macann 1993, Jaspers 1963).
