Phytophthora infestans (Phytophthora blight)

The three most invasive rat species, black or ship rat *Rattus rattus*, brown or Norway rats, *R. norvegicus* and Pacific rat, *R. exulans* have been incrementally introduced to islands as humans have explored the world's oceans. Emerald ash borer (EAB), *Agrilus planipennis* Fairmaire, is an exotic beetle that was discovered in southeastern Michigan near Detroit in the summer of 2002. The adult beetles nibble on ash foliage but cause little damage. The larvae (the immature stage) feed on the inner bark of ash trees, disrupting the tree's ability to transport water and nutrients.
